Our programs hold approvals from esteemed regulatory bodies including the Pharmacy Council of India (PCI), the All India Council of Technical Education (AICTE), and the University Grants Commission (UGC) for 2f and 12B categories. Additionally, our research endeavors are endorsed by the Department of Science and Industrial Research and the Department of Technical Education, Government of Andhra Pradesh. We have been recognized as a Ph.D. research centre by Acharya Nagarjuna University, and our quality management systems are certified under ISO 9001:2015 standards. Achieving autonomous status from the UGC in 2016 further underscores our commitment to academic excellence. Permanently affiliated with Acharya Nagarjuna University, our institute also boasts an MSME-approved Business Incubation Centre, fostering innovation and entrepreneurship. Notably, our institution has been consistently ranked by the National Institutional Ranking Framework (NIRF) since 2017, achieving a commendable 89th position at the all-India level in 2023. 01. ACHIEVEMENTS




