REGULATIONS FOR BANNING RAGGING

AND ANTI – RAGGING MEASURES OF

CHALAPATHI INSTITUTE OF PHARMACEUTICAL SCIENCES, GUNTUR

AIM:-

To toot out ragging in all its forms from the Chalapathi Institute of Pharmaceutical Sciences by instituting stringent Anti–Ragging measures and provisions for strict punishments to defaulters.

MEASURES FOR CURBING RAGGING:-

- 1. Application form & especially the Registration form at the time of Registration for a semester will require two affidavits on Rs.10.00 stamp paper each, duly notarized, one signed by the student & the other signed by the parent, Draft of the affidavits required are given at:
 - i) Annexure By the Student
 - ii) Annexure By the Parent
- 2. A student will not admitted / registered until the affidavits are submitted.
- 3. Student who are allotted hostel accommodation are required to submit three copies of details of parents & local guardian along with their photographs. Students will not be registered & assigned hostel seat until the above document is submitted at the time of registration for the hostel.
- 4. Create awareness through wide spread publicity –posters, leaflets etc., among the students, parents & guardians before start of the academic session the poster & banners etc., will be displayed at least 10days before the start of this semester in all prominent places including hostels, cafeterias, common activity areas & entry points.



- 5. Every student at the time of registration will be given a leaflet giving details of Anti Ragging Regulations for which he will sign having received it & its record will remaintained.
- **6.** The Head of the Institution will create awareness & explain the consequences of ragging in the orientation / Induction Programmes of fresher & seniors. Fresher shall be encouraged to report incidents of ragging either as victims or even as a witness.
- 7. Every non hostel student, at the time of Registration will provide full particulars of his stay during the semester, whether staying with parents, relatives, friends, hired hostel / PG accommodation.
- **8.** Every hostel student will provide three copies of full details of father and mother & local guardian with three copies of their photographs of which one copy will be with reception/gate, second copy with the Head of the Institution.

Rules & regulations for prevention and prohibition of ragging

The All India Council For Technical Education (AICTE), New Delhi vide its Notification no.37-3-/Legal/AICTE/2009 dated 25.03.2009 has taken a very serious view of ragging incidences in educational institutions and on Directions of the Hon'ble supreme Court of India vide its order dated;-16.05.2007 has ordered strict implementation of following rules & regulations for prevention and prohibition of Ragging in technical Institutions.

VARIOUS TYPES OF RAGGING

The Hon'ble Supreme Court has, inter – alia, mentioned the following types of ragging:-

- 1. Ragging has several aspects with, among others, psychological, social, political, economic, cultural and academic dimensions.
- 2. Any act that prevents, disrupts or disturbs the regular academic activity of a student should be considered within the academics related aspect of ragging; similarly, exploiting the services of a junior student for completing the academic tasks assigned to an individual or a group of seniors is also an aspect of academics related ragging prevalent in many institutions, particularly in the technical institutions.
- 3. Any act of financial extortion to forceful expenditure burden put on a junior student by senior students should be considered an aspect of ragging for ragging economic dimensions.
- 4. Any act of physical abuse including all variants of it: sexual abuse, homosexual assaults, stripping, forcing obscene and lewd acts, gestured, causing bodily harm or any other danger to health or person can be put in the category of ragging with criminal dimensions.

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- 5. Any act or abuse by spoken words, emails, snail mails, blogs, public insults should be considered within the psychological aspects of ragging. This aspect would also include deriving perverted pleasure, vicarious or sadistic thrill from actively or passively participating in the discomfiture to others; the absence of preparing 'freshers' in the run up to their admission to higher education and life in hostels also can be ascribed as a psychological aspect of ragging coping skills in interaction with senior or strangers can be impacted by parent as well. Any act that affects the mental health and self confidence of students also can be described in terms of the psychological aspects of ragging.
- **6.** The human rights perspective of ragging involves the injury caused to the fundamental right to human dignity through humiliation heaped on junior students by seniors: often resulting in the extreme step t suicide by the victims.

ACTIONS TO BE TAKEN AGAINST STUDENTS FOR INCLUDING AND ABETTING IN RAGGING IN TECHNICAL INSTITUTIONS UNIVERSITIES INCLUDING DEEMED TO BE UNIVERSITY IMPARTING TECHNICAL EDUCATION:-

- 1. The punishment to be meted out to the persons indulged in ragging has to be exemplary and justifiably harsh to act as a deterrent against recurrence of such incidents. The students who are found to be indulged in ragging should be debarred from taking admission in any technical institution in India.
- 2. Every single incident of ragging a First information Report (FIR) must be filed without exception by the institutional authorities with the local police authorities.
- 3. Depending upon the nature and gravity of the offence as established by the Anti Ragging Committee of the institution, the possible punishment for those found guilty of ragging at the institution level shall be any one or any combination of the following.
 - i) Cancellation of admission
 - ii) Suspension from attending classes
 - iii) Withholding/ withdrawing scholarship / fellowship and other benefits
 - iv) Debarring from appearing in any test/examination or other evaluation process
 - v) Withholding results
 - vi) Debarring from representing the institution in any regional, national or international meet, tournament, youth festival, etc.,
 - vii) Rustication from the institution for period ragging from 1 to 4 semesters
 - viii) Suspension/expulsion from hostel
 - ix) Expulsion from the institution and consequent debarring from admission to any other institution.
 - x) Fine Rupees 25,000/-



- xi) Collective punishment: when the persons committing or abetting the crime of ragging are not identified, the institution shall resort to collective punishment as a deterrent to ensure community pressure on the potential raggers.
- **4.** The institutional authority shall intimate the incidents of ragging occurred in their premises along with actions taken to the Council immediately after occurrence of such incident and inform the status of the case from time to time.
- **5.** Courts should make an effort to ensure that cases involving ragging are taken up on priority basis to send the correct message that ragging is not only to be discouraged but also to be dealt with sternness.

SETTING UP OF ANTI – RAGGING COMMITTEE, ANTI –RAGGING SQUARD AND THEIR FUNCTIONS

THE ANTI - RAGGING COMMITTEE:

The Anti – Ragging Committee shall be headed by the Head of the Institution & shall consist of representatives of Civil & Police administration, Local media, non – government organizations involved in youth activities, faculty members, parents, students belonging to the fresher's category as well as senior & non – teaching staff. It shall monitor the Anti Ragging activities in the institution, consider the recommendations of the Anti – Ragging squad & take appropriate decisions, including spelling out suitable punishments to those found guilty.

THE ANTI – RAGGING SQUARD:

The Anti Ragging squad shall be nominated by the Head of the Institution with such representation as considered necessary & shall exclusively consist of members belonging to the various sections of the campus community. The Squad shall have vigil, oversight & patrolling functions. It shall be kept mobile, alert & active at all times & shall be empowered to inspect places of potential ragging and make surprise raids on hostels & other hot spots. The squad shall investigate incidents of ragging and make work under the overall guidance of the Anti – Ragging Committee.



GRIEVANCE REDRESSAL CELL

Chalapathi institute of Pharmaceutical Sciences provides an effective mechanism to promptly resolve all students and staff grievances. With an objective of smooth and fair functioning of the institution without any grievances to students and staff and to attain the vision of the institution, the following categories of grievance will be redressed. In case the person is unwilling to himself/herself, grievance may be dropped in writing at the complaint box of the Grievance Cell at various places in the campus. All grievance are redressed in a systematic way to the specific issue. Redressal cell convenes meeting periodically and takes steps to redress the grievance.

Outcome based Grievance Redressal system:

- Well defined disciplinary system and to make it acceptable to all stakeholders.
- All actions taken are prompt for better redressal of a grievance.
- To make the redressal process fair, impartial, consistent, with prior warnings with gravity of misconduct.
- Emphasize on prevention of misconduct rather than controlling through corrective measures.

Nature of grievances:

- Institutional grievances including hostel grievances
- Examination grievances
- Financial grievances
- Academic grievances
- Any other grievances

Institutional grievances: Institutional and hostel grievances to be redressed by grievance redressal cell include infrastructural maintenance complaints, electrical complaints, cleaning complaints in the campus. Institutional grievances will be addressed within 3-4 days

Examinational grievances: Grievance related to timely issue of mark —sheets, transfer certificates, conduct certificates or other examination related matters, typographical errors on the marks memos or other matters related to examination. Examination grievances will be redressed within 10-15 days.

Chalapathi Institute of Pharmaceutical Sciences
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Financial grievance: Financial matters related to dues and payments for various items like fees, fines, library, bus and hostel dues. Financial grievances will be addressed by the management within 4-5 days.

Academic grievances: Grievances related to student dissatisfaction towards teaching related issues. Academic grievances will be addressed within 2-3 days.

Students or staff can approach the Grievance Redressal Cell and submit their grievance in this format:

Mechanism of Redressal

Grievance related to institution and academic issues will be redressed within 1-2days, Examination grievances will be redressed within 10-15 days, Academic grievances will be addressed within 2-3 days, financial grievances will be addressed by the management within 7-15 days.

- The complaint and suggestion boxes will be checked one a week.
- The committee will meet as and when a grievance received and conducts a discussion on the mature of the grievance.
- The complaint will be called for a private discussion.
- The offending party (if any) will also be called for a private discussion
- The committee will offer suitable measures to resolve the problem and to the satisfaction of the complainant.
- The offering party (if any) will be subjected to suitable corrective action if necessary.

POLICY AGAINST SEXUAL HARASSMENT OF WOMEN AT THE WORKPLACE

1. Preamble

The Parliament of India passed the "Sexual Harassment of Women at Workplace (Prevention, Prohibition, and Redressal) Act," in the year 2013. The Act provides protection against sexual harassment of women at workplace and for the prevention and Redressal of complaints of sexual harassment and for the matters connected therewith or incidental thereto.

The guidelines explicitly state the following: "It shall be the duty of the employer or other responsible persons in workplaces or other institutions to prevent or deter the commission of acts of sexual harassment and to provide the procedures for the resolutions, settlement, or prosecution of acts, of sexual harassment by taking all steps require."

2. Objectives

The objectives of the Internal Complaint Committee to Prevent Sexual Harassment of Women at the Workplace are as follows:

- To develop a policy against sexual harassment of women at the Institute.
- To evolve a permanent mechanism for the prevention and Redressal of sexual harassment cases and other acts of gender based violence at the Institute.
- To ensure the implementation of the policy in letter and spirit through proper reporting of the complaints and their follow-up procedures.
- To uphold the commitment of the Institute to provide an environment free of gender based discrimination.
- To create a secure physical and social environment to deter any act of sexual harassment.
- To promote a social and psychological environment to raise awareness on sexual harassment in its various forms.

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3. Code of Conduct for workplace:

Sexual harassment is a serious criminal offence, which can destroy human dignity and freedom. In an effort to promote the well being of all human employees at the workplace the following code of conduct has been prescribed:-

- 1. It shall be the duty of the employer to prevent or deter the commission of any act of sexual harassment at the workplace.
- 2. Sexual harassment will include such unwelcome sexually determined behaviou by any person either individually or in association with other persons or by any person in authority whether directly or by implication such as:
 - i. Eve-teasing
 - ii. Unsavory remark
 - iii. Jocks causing or likely to cause awkwardness or embarrassment
 - iv. Innuendos and taunts
 - v. Gender based insults or sexiest remark
 - vi. Unwelcome sexual overtone in any manner such as over telephone (obnoxious telephone calls) and the like
 - vii. Touching or brushing against any part of the body and the like
 - viii. Displaying pornographic or other offensive or derogatory pictures, cartoons, pamphlets or sayings.
 - ix. Forcible physical touch or molestation
 - x. Physical confinement against one's will and any other act likely to violate one's privacy.

And include any act or conduct by a person in authority and belonging career development or otherwise making the environment at the workplace. Hostile or intimidating to a person belonging to the other sex, only on the ground of sex.



4. Constitution of the Internal Committee

The Committee shall consist of following nine members, who shall be appointed by the Principal of the Institution as under, namely:

- 1. A senior female faculty member from the Institute, as the Chairperson
- 2. Two faculty members (one female and one male)
- 3. Two staff members (one female and one male from Group 'B' & 'C')
- 4. Three PhD students (two females and one male)
- 5. One External female member (preferably lawyer by profession of from NGO committed to the cause of women or familiar with issues related to sexual harassment)
- 6. At least one of the members shall be a woman belonging to the Scheduled Castes or the Scheduled Tribes or the Other Backward Classes or Minority Community notified by the Central Government, from time to time.
- 7. The term of each member shall be of three years
- 8. The previous committee members will continue till the new committee is constituted at the end of three years term.

5. Meeting of the Committee:

The members of the Committee shall meet at least two times in a year. The Chairperson shall preside over the meeting. In the absence of the Chairperson, the second senior female faculty member shall preside over the meeting. The Chairperson may upon the request of not less than one third of the total members of the Committee, call a meeting on a date not later than fifteen days after the receipt of such requisition.

- 1. The quorum of the meeting of the Committee shall be five of its members. If the quorum is not complete in any meeting, it shall be adjourned for half an hour and thereafter, the meeting shall precede with those members who are present in the meeting.
- 2. All decision in the meeting will be taken through mutual consent from the members of the Committee present in the meeting. In the case of any disagreement among the members regarding any decision, Chairperson of the Committee shall hold the authority to take the final decision and her decision would be considered as final.
