Specific facilities provided for women in terms of:

a. Safety and Security

The institution is strictly concerned about the Safety and Security offemale students and was stringently not permitted to leave outside the campus without the consent of their parents or care takers.

- Separate hostels for girls were provided in the campus.
- Resident wardens were provided for each and every hostel.
- CC Surveillance Cameras were installed in each and every lab and class room, corridors and Hostels for the safety assurance of the students, since 2015.
- Security gourds were present 24x7 within the campus to ensure security of the students.
- Sufficient lighting is provided in the campus during nights in case of extension of regular hours for placements or cultural activities.
- Women faculty members accompany girl students when they participate in outdoor activities like seminars, conferences at National and International level.
- The institute have Anti Ragging cell which appoints anti ragging squad consists of male and female staff and student members for frequent visits to hostels, to aware all on antiragging and to have a check for safety of students.
- The Grievance- Redressal cell, internal complaint committee interacts regularly with the girl students and resolves the issues if any addressed by them.
- A complaint box is also arranged in the campus to invite the student problems if they feel difficult to express the same with committees and cells of the institution.
- Emergency contact numbers are also displayed in prominent places of the campus.
- Awareness programmes on self-defensive techniques, safe driving measures are also organized by various committees of the institution and also conducted during pharmacy science exhibition which will be conducted annually.



b. Counselling

Frequent counselling is done to the students in various means by the involvement of separate committees of the institution.

- Mentor-Mentee system of the institution addresses the issues of the students in terms of academic activities, physical facilities and administrative support.
- One mentor is allocated for each 15-20 students, and the problems are recorded for each class of all programmes.
- Academic coordinator monitors the students and counsel the students regarding depression or misbehavior.
- Frequent sessions on career development and life skills are organized by IQAC of the institution.
- NSS cell of the institution organizes various personality development and other extension activities that creates self-awareness among students.

C. Common Rooms

- Girls waiting halls and restrooms are provided in each block in the campus with required facilities.
- Pharmacy supported by Pradhanmantri Bharatiya Jan Aushadi Kendra (PMBJAK)
 with qualified Pharmacist. Monitoring of BP, Diabetes and BMI is assessed in the
 respective area, counselled regarding their health status and dispense medicines
 accordingly.
- Separate enough space is provided for girls in the library of the institution.
 Separate attendants were employed in library to manage the activities of library regarding safe and security.
